Ordinance No. ~~444~~

Article I

BIG SHAG LAKE

The Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, ordains:

On the waters of Big Shag Lake, Sec. 25, 26 and 36, T 45 N, R 26 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, shall:

- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which means a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition, or
- (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

On those waters of Big Shag Lake lying between a line from the northwest corner of Government Lot No. 4 running southwest to the opposite shore and a line 500 feet south therefrom and running from the most easterly to the west shore of the lake, Sec. 25, T 45 N, R 26 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat shall exceed a slow -- no wake speed, which means a very slow speed whereby the wake or wash created by the motorboat would be minimal.

Article II

LITTLE SHAG LAKE

The Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, ordains:

On the waters of Little Shag Lake, Sec. 31, T 45 N, R 25 W, and Sec. 36, T 45 N, R 26 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, shall:

- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which means a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition, or
- (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

Article III

JOHNSON LAKE

The Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, ordains:

On the waters of Johnson Lake, Sec. 27, T 45 N, R 25 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, shall:

- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which means a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition, or
- (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

Article IV

BASS LAKE

The Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, ordains:

On the waters of Bass Lake, Sec. 29 and 30, T 45 N, R 26 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, shall:

- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which means a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition, or
- (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

Article V

FARMERS LAKE

The Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, ordains:

On the waters of Farmers Lake, Sec. 16 and 17, T 45 N, R 24 W, Township of Forsyth, County of Marquette, State of Michigan, no operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, shall:

- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which means a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition, or
- (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.
