At a meeting of the Forsyth Township Board Township, Marquette County, Michigan, held at the Gwinn Community Center on June 27, 2019, at 6:30 p.m., Township Board Member Treasurer Judith Roberts moved to adopt the following Ordinance, which motion was seconded by Township Board Member Trustee Chris Adams:

An Ordinance to repeal Forsyth Township Ordinance No. 3-90, entitled "Herbicide, Defoliant, Desiccant, and Plant Regulator Ordinance."

FORSYTH TOWNSHIP, MARQUETTE COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 3-90. Ordinance No. 3-90, the Forsyth Township Herbicide, Defoliant, Desiccant, and Plant Regulator Ordinance, previously adopted by Forsyth Township on December 2, 1990 shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after notice of its adoption is published in a local newspaper.
