ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING MEDICAL AND
ADULT-USE MARIHUANA
ORDINANCE NO. 2-2022**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Forsyth Township, Marquette County, Michigan, held at the Gwinn Community Center on October 27, 2022 at 6:30 p.m., Township Board Member Trustee Bodenus moved to adopt the following Ordinance Amendment, which motion was seconded by Township Board Member Treasurer Kevern:

An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance Authorizing and Permitting Medical and Adult-Use Marihuana, Ordinance No. 1-2021, replace section 6 paragraph 11

THE TOWNSHIP OF FORSYTH ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 6. Part 11. Section 6, Part 11. of the Ordinance Authorizing and Permitting Medical and Adult-Use Marihuana, Ordinance No.1-2021, shall be amended to read as follows:

11. Sign Restrictions. All signs shall comply with all applicable Local, State, or Federal Law or Rule governing Facilities or Establishments. A Permitted Premises or Permitted Property may not contain flashing or animated signs.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance Amendment shall take effect the day following the date of publication after adoption by the Township Board.

Section 3. Repeal. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
